ORDINANCE NO. 110922D

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION CONTROLLING AND KEEPING OF ANIMALS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Aldermen of the City of Wheaton, Missouri desire to enact an ordinance defining and regarding regulation controlling and keeping of animals within the City Limits of the City of Wheaton.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WHEATON, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, harbor or possess any livestock, including fowl, except domestic chickens pursuant to the ordinances regulating the same and cattle and horses in an agricultural zone pursuant to the zoning ordinance.

SECTION TWO: Upon conviction of a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during with the violation occurs or continues.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance supersedes and revokes any provisions of past ordinance(s) inconsistent with the provision of this ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision, or the application thereof, which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FIVE: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its final passage and approval.

SECTION SIX: Said approval being effective the 9th day of November 2022.
